ARRIVAL by Air – how to get to the city centre

The city's international airport, Lennart Meri Tallinn Airport is just 4 km from the city centre – means transport to most destinations takes surprisingly little time.

Bus no. 2 makes the trip from the airport to the city centre and port approximately every 20 minutes and operates from ~6:30 am until midnight. Single journey tickets can be bought in cash from the driver for €2. The bus departs from the airport's lowest level, down the escalator from the arrivals hall. The most central stop is the Laikmaa stop on Laikmaa Street, between the Tallink Hotel and the Viru Centre shopping mall, attached to the Sokos Hotel Viru.

Tram no. 4 from the airport to the city centre operates a frequent schedule from 5:30 am until 00:45. The tram stop is located next to the terminal towards the city. Single journey tickets can be bought in cash from the driver for €2. The most central stop is the Viru stop.

A **taxi stand** can be found just outside the arrivals hall. The fare from the airport to the city centre is about €5 to €10. Read more about Tallinn's taxis here.

TAXIS

Taxis can be found lined-up at taxi stands (in front of larger hotels and at some key intersections) and can be ordered on the phone or via various mobile apps (see below).

Rates are not uniform – they are set by the taxi company or operator, and can vary widely. Each taxi's rates are posted on a yellow sticker on the car's right rear window. The cost usually consists of a base fare (starting fare) plus a per-kilometer fare. If you want to avoid misunderstandings, you can ask the driver the approximate cost of the trip in advance. Make sure to specify whether the price is per ride or per person!

Driver-requesting and taxi-ordering mobile apps

If you use a smartphone and are also willing to pay for a ride by a local driver, then you can download one of several popular driver-requesting apps.

There are three choices that are particularly popular:

1. [Taxofon](#), which offers only taxis (as Tallink and Tulika).
2. [Taxify](#), which offers verified private drivers as well as taxis.
3. [Uber](#), which offers only private drivers.

Before using one of the apps, make sure you are aware of their terms of use.
